



# HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE TO THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the <u>Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults</u>. This document is also available online at <u>www.archdioceseofhartford.org</u>. The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.

Thank you for all the welcomes warm received following this past weekend's Masses. A bit about me: I grew up in Windsor, gradu-Windsor ated from High School in 2013, and then graduated UConn with computer engineering degree in 2017. While I always liked going to Mass growing up, it was the joyful group of peers I met at the

UConn Catholic Center who inspired me to put God at the center of my life. It was there that I first began to think about the priesthood.

After college, I spent two years as a FOCUS missionary sharing the Gospel through authentic friendship on college campuses in PA and NY. #### FAITH FORMATION PROGRAMS FOR 2022-2023

\* This coming year in September the St. Junipero Serra Faith Formation program is planning on offering in-person Whole Parish Catechesis (Gr. K – 6) and Gr. 7 – 10 Classes for the 2022-2023 academic year. If there are any different directives that come from the Archdiocese due to COVID, we will revert to virtual classes and sessions as needed in the same manner as this past year.

Saint Junipero Serra Parish, along with the Bishops of the United States "are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission 'for the life of the world' is excited to highlight the source and summit of our faith."

CCC1324 The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucha-

rist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch."

As such all of our program's sessions from Grades K-10 will **begin with Mass** followed by a light lunch and family catechesis class. We hope to instill a fire and love for the Holy Mass and Eucharist, as well as build up our Church and families by breaking bread, fellowship, and learning together.

The parent is the main teacher, and these lessons are meant to enhance or add to what the parents will be teaching such as projects, prayer, and at home practice which will be suggested at each class along with pertinent handouts and suggested family engagement.

More than anything our goal this year is to bring families back to Mass. For we know that the goal of catechesis is not just to learn about Jesus, but to meet him in the Eucharist, and the other Sacraments and then go forth to our homes, and neighborhoods, and bring His light into the world.

CCC2225 Through the grace of the sacrament of marriage, parents receive the responsibility and privilege of evangelizing their children. Parents should initiate their children at an early age into the mysteries of the faith of which they are the "first heralds" for their children. They should associate them from their tenderest years with the life of the Church. 34 A whole-some family life can foster interior dispositions that are a genuine preparation for a living faith and remain a support for it throughout one's life.

CCC2226 Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This already happens when family members help one another to grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Family catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. 35 The parish is the Eucharistic community and the heart of the liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents.

CCC2227 Children in turn contribute to the growth in holiness of their parents. 36 Each and everyone should be generous and tireless in forgiving one another for offenses, quarrels, injustices, and neglect. Mutual affection suggests this. The charity of Christ demands it.


