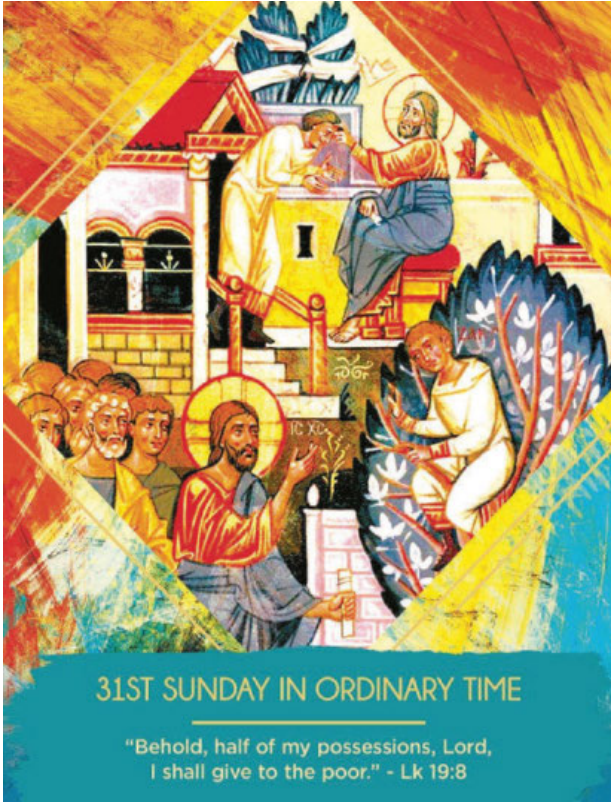

Dear Parishioners,

In addition to the pastoral responsibilities, we continue working on some of the projects that we have to complete so that the maintenance and good condition of the two churches are maintained for several more years.

A couple of days ago we have successfully fixed the heating systems in both churches. That being said, in the next few weeks, maintenance and repair of the deterioration of the large wall behind the altar of SMM church will begin. The wall has cracks and internal cavities which in one or two more years could cause the detachment of the plaster and its internal mesh. We must proceed as soon as possible to carry out this project before the damage to the wall becomes more serious. The company that will carry out this project has a lot of experience with church repairs, in fact they carried out the restoration of St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York. The estimated time for this work will be around 4 weeks.

With God's help, the work will be ready by Thanksgiving week, meanwhile we continue to pray and work together to keep our parish serving our families.
