

CANDLE PRAYER



Candles have long traditionally had significance in prayer and rituals in the Catholic Church.

CCC1243 The white garment symbolizes that the person baptized has "put on Christ," 42 has risen with Christ. The candle, lit from the Easter candle, signifies that Christ has enlightened the neophyte. In him the baptized are "the light of the world."

Beyond the stone of church walls, Though dim and unscheduled for a Mass, flames flicker intensely through the glass,

Lit in faith,
hands held up to God,
A gesture of prayer in the dark,
The yellow glow dances in hope,
Keeping watch throughout the night,
Holding our prayers of light,
from a single flame in vigil,
An offering,
a symbol,
That God are Father's will be dance.

That God our Father's will be done, On Earth as it is in Heaven! And for those who have passed away We pray in Light!

We remember the holy souls in Purgatory during the month of November,

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

All the darkness in the world cannot extinguish the light of a single candle.

– St. Francis of Assisi

III. THE FINAL PURIFICATION, OR PURGATORY

1030 All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven.

1031 The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned.606

1032 This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin."609 From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God.610 The Church also commends

almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead:

Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them.611
