



GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE January 1, 2023 Mary, The Holy Mother of God

We hide ourselves and our secrets from God because we are afraid. Even Mary can seem too perfect to approach. The shepherds find the strength to speak to Mary and Joseph at the moment they see the child in the manger. They open their hearts and share what they've experienced. Saint Luke writes of the shepherds, "When they saw this, they made known the message that had been told them about this child."

When I was a college student, I visited Rome. Beggars often approached and said, "Mangia? Mangia?" I didn't speak Italian and thought, "Why are they speaking about the Christmas nativity scene?" My friend said, "Mangia means eat. They're hungry." That's when I realized more deeply than ever before that Mary puts her baby in a place designed for hungry animals to eat.

See that baby in the manger in your heart. Imagine Mary kneeling nearby looking at you with love. She doesn't cling to God for herself. In that cave, from the beginning, she quietly offers her son to hungry souls. The manger means vulnerable self-offering love. That's the sign. This week that same manger opens our hearts to tell Mary about our lives, too. — Father John Muir ©LPi



The first day of the calendar year is the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God - Theotokos - Perhaps in this new year, we can think of her more often. We can ponder about the Mother of God who is also our Mother and who loves us very much.

There is a beautiful song sung in Spanish by Kiko Arugello, *Maria*, *Pequena Maria* - The song is a beautiful poem where he ponders who she is. I share the translation with you below.

Maria, Little Maria

Little Mary, Little Mary, you are the gentle breeze of Elijah The whisper of God's spirit You are the burning bush of Moses, You carry the Lord But are not consumed

You are the place beside me, Who showed the Lord to Moses, You are the cleft in the rock That God covers with his hand As his glory passes by,

The Lord come with us If we have found favor in his sight It is certain that we are sinners

But pray for us and we'll be your people and your inheritance

Little Mary
Daughter of Jerusalem,
mother of all peoples
Virgin of Nazareth

You are the cloud of the desert That protects the march of Israel You are the tent of meeting The ark that carries the covenant The sanctuary of God's glory

Let the Lord come with us
If we have found favor in your sight
It is certain that we are sinners
But pray for us, and we shall be your people and your inheritance



"What was prefigured at that time in the flame of the bush was openly manifested in the mystery of the Virgin, once an interval of time had passed. Just as on the mountain the bush burned but was not consumed, so also the Virgin gave birth to the light and was not corrupted. Nor should you consider the comparison to the bush to be embarrassing, for it prefigures the God-bearing body of the Virgin.

Saint Gregory of Nyssa, an extraordinary theologian and bishop of the fourth century.

Mary - "ever-virgin"

CCC499 The deepening of faith in the virginal motherhood led the Church to confess Mary's real and perpetual virginity even in the act of giving birth to the Son of God made man. In fact, Christ's birth "did not diminish his mother's virginal integrity but sanctified it." And so the liturgy of the Church celebrates Mary as Aeiparthenos, the "Ever-virgin".

Against this doctrine the objection is sometimes raised that the Bible mentions brothers and sisters of Jesus. The Church has always understood these passages as not referring to other children of the Virgin Mary. In fact James and Joseph, "brothers of Jesus", are the sons of another Mary, a disciple of Christ, whom St. Matthew significantly calls "the other Mary".

They are close relations of Jesus, according to an Old Testament expression.

Jesus is Mary's only son, but her spiritual motherhood extends to all men whom indeed he came to save: "The Son whom she brought forth is he whom God placed as the first-born among many brethren, that is, the faithful in whose generation and formation she co-operates with a mother's love."
