

#### GOSPEL MEDITATION

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When I was a kid, I remember the priest at Mass announcing, "The Lamb of God!" Frankly, it struck me as nonsense. I thought: Why in the world does God have a lamb? And where is this lamb?

John the Baptist sees Jesus coming toward him and announces, "Behold the lamb of God." His Jewish listeners knew what he meant. God's lamb is the thing that is sacrificed at the Jewish Passover and consumed by the participants. For almost a thousand years, lambs were ritually slaughtered and eaten in Jerusalem at Passover. The lamb meant sacrifice, freedom from sin, and communion with God. The Baptist is saying in effect, "This man will

be ritually sacrificed and consumed so that God's people may be free from sin and united to God."

It's crucial to relate to Jesus as a friend, brother, teacher, and Lord of our lives. But we should also learn to interact with Him as our lamb of God. That means we intentionally place on him our sins, sadnesses, and hopes, and offer him to God. Then we consume him to make us free. This is what we do at every Mass. That's why he is the Lamb of God.






## Our Parish Youth Group is forming!

## Meet our Catechist: Sarah Blackwell

Please introduce a bit about yourself and your family life in one - two sentences.

My husband, Ian and I are parents to two daughters and we welcomed our first grandchild in 2021. We bought an old house from family friends in Vernon and renovated it ourselves 10 years ago. I try to grow vegetables every year in my big backyard garden. Maybe you've heard me singing at church?? I'm a lifelong choir member and cantor for the last 15 years.

How long have you been a catechist and what inspired you to teach the youth about God and His church?

I like to think I've been teaching you about God through our singing together, but this is my first-year teaching confirmation. I LOVE church, so learning more about the magisterium as I prepare to teach has been amazing. I love old fashioned things and believe our most beautiful prayers and music will be restored. We can honor tradition and still maintain progress! This is my prayer.

Do you have a memorable experience in which God, or the Blessed Mother has touched your life?

Yes! This story is deeply personal, so I will not be sharing it here, but I KNOW God is real because of this experience. Nothing is impossible for God. Keep praying.

If you could send the children away with one message about the importance of the Mass and the Eucharist what would that be?

I would like each child to know that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist and to believe He is calling you from the tabernacle, saying, "I am always happy to see you! I am always happy to be with you! Thank you for loving me and giving me the first hour of your new week! I'm always here. Come and spend time with me."


Which Gospel story is your favorite and why?

I love the Gospel of John. (I like to read the English and Latin side by side...) "In the beginning was the Word. And the Word was with God. And the Word was God." I just love this introduction to the Birth of Christ. Did you know? This used to be heard at the end of every mass. Try reading it privately before you leave the church after Mass and spend a few extra moments contemplating the Incarnation.

Do you have a prayer that you pray every day? How were you introduced to that prayer and why has it touched your life?

I daily pray the rosary. Our Lady is indeed the Mediatrix of Graces, and I encourage all the faithful to go To Jesus Through Mary. I also try to do morning and evening prayer. Growing up, I was blessed with good, Catholic grandparents, who were daily Mass goers. They prayed together and sang together, brought communion to the homebound, etc. I saw firsthand how much joy their faith brought to them and to others as I tagged along on Sundays after Mass and choir practice. They always included me in their parish activities, and I loved all their friends. We shared the best of life together as a parish family, and I seek to recreate this in my life today- God willing!


