## Perseverance



"Say the Rosary every day to obtain peace for the world."

-Our Lady of Fatima

There is a man who lives in my neighborhood who walks every day rain or shine. Some days I will see the sun shining and think what a wonderful day for a walk. But he catches my attention most on those hot and humid days or frigid winter nights because there he will still be steadily taking his walk.

And so it is that I am reminded to persevere in prayer. I can do this by practicing a good habit of daily prayer so that when the storms of life approach I can keep on as Saint Ignatius of Loyola would instruct in his 5th rule - In the Discernment of Spirits - Keep and go even just one step more. If you pray one hour usually pray instead one hour and I minute, when you are tempted in the storm not to pray.

Fifth Rule. "although in desolation we should not change our first proposals, it is very advantageous to change ourselves intensely against the desolation itself, as by insisting more upon prayer, meditation, upon much examination, and upon extending ourselves in some suitable way of doing penance"

### Perseverance

In the gray, cold, early, evening hours -Most hurried on their way, But he walked steady as expected, Beneath the winter skies of gray -

Even the leaves had told their branches, Tis cold – I mustn't stay – But there the old man walked still, With his back crooked as a cane –

And though the evening fast approaches, And none would judge him either way, Not snow, not ice, not cold, would change him, His quiet footsteps seemed to sayAt times the tree's brittle branches, Would creak and snap and say- no way – But even the gale of winter wind mixed in, with wet and cold winter rain,

Never doubted for a moment, His loyal footsteps as they came, And a great tall pine bowed heavy, with white snowdrift,

swore once to his great name, That none the difference, did the weather change him, but made him whistle down the lane...

CCC2742 "Pray constantly . . . always and for everything giving thanks in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God the Father." St. Paul adds, "Pray at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance making supplication for all the saints." For "we have not been commanded to work, to keep watch and to fast constantly, but it has been laid down that we are to pray without ceasing." This tireless fervor can come only from love. Against our dullness and laziness, the battle of prayer is that of humble, trusting, and persevering love. This love opens our hearts to three enlightening and life-giving facts of faith about prayer.
