





## OUR LADY OF THE BROOM

One of the most striking  
qualities of a mother is her  
inability to sleep when she  
worries for her children.  
Their problems are her prob-  
lems. Their concerns are her  
concerns. And though moth-  
ers may spend much of their  
time doing the household  
tasks of cooking and clean-  
ing, all that too, solidifies the  
home for her children. She  
prepares a place for them, to  
have rest and peace. The

Recently I was at the thrift store and I found a statue of *Our Lady of the Broom*. Her face is sad and in her hand is a broom. I was struck by how often I have swept the floors and prayed for my children. Then I was struck by the realization that as I swept and prayed, she did too.

I think in your hand will be a broom,  
Around you will be darkness,  
But you will be all aglow,  
And though your hands will be smooth  
and your skin perfect light,  
I will know you in the instant  
your eyes reach mine,  
That you swept and you cleaned

That until I was home,  
You never shut an eye,  
And all the while that you prayed,  
You swept up the sky!
