
Pray for a Thousand New Priests!

This is not about technicalities; it's about fervently praying for new priestly vocations. Fasting should be done in keeping with the spirit and instruction of the disciplines of the Church. If you are not able to fast from food, you can substitute some other convenience or comfort instead.


