

Dear Parishioners,

Every day we pray for priestly vocations because we are aware of the shortage of priests in our archdiocese. The last time this parish was blessed to two priests serving the community was in 2020. In these last 4 years I have been able to serve both churches, 4 nursing homes and other hospitals and facilities around South Windsor and Hartford, funerals, appointments, communion calls, and among other pastoral, archdiocesan and administrative responsibilities. I understand that some spiritual personal needs want to be attended to in the moment we face them, and we do not know when these may reach our families and lives, but we need to be aware and try to understand that I am the only priest assigned to this great parish. I try to care for and attend to every need that arises daily. Although I'm still "young" as some people say, I also need one day off a week, which is every Friday. This day I am not in the rectory or the office. I have tried to serve the parish as much as I can and when time allows, and although I know that I am not perfect, I have always done so with pastoral zeal, dedication and love for Jesus and priestly service.

I strongly ask that you please try to understand that when I cannot attend a call, an appointment, anointing of the sick or other family or personal emergency, it is not because I do not want to but because I am also trying to meet other needs in the parish or because I am not in the office at the moment people call. So, let us continue praying for more vocations in our archdiocese, in this way the pastoral service of our parishes will be more abundant and fruitful. May the Lord continue to bless us and help us in our spiritual, family and personal journey.






