



Along the Beam - Worldview

It is common to hear of truth spoken today as developed by a personal worldview. Decisions are based on where a person is coming from or from a particular relative circumstance.

But if the truth is determined by how each person feels or thinks, it would be impossible to be certain if one choice, or the other, was truly right or truly wrong.

As Catholics, we are rooted in the truth of Christ and his Church. All things should be seen in light of Him and His teachings.

C.S. Lewis talks about the difference between what a person sees when they look directly at something and the more that a person is able to see when they look "along" something.

"I was standing today in the dark toolshed. The sun was shining outside and through the crack at the top of the door there came a sunbeam. From where I stood that beam of light, with the specks of dust floating in it, was the most striking thing in the place. Everything else was almost pitch-black. I was seeing the beam, not seeing things by it.

Then I moved, so that the beam fell on my eyes. Instantly the whole previous picture vanished. I saw no toolshed, and (above all) no beam. Instead I saw, framed in the irregular cranny at the top of the door, green leaves moving on the branches of a tree outside and beyond that, 90 odd million miles away, the sun. Looking along the beam, and looking at the beam are very different experiences. "C.S. Lewis



Maybe it could be said that this beam of light is the Church. Looking along the beam of the church we find understanding in God's moral code, regardless of how we feel or our present circumstances. We can take what happens to us in our own lives and find God's way through it.

THE MORAL LAW

CCC1950 *The moral law* is the work of divine Wisdom. Its biblical meaning can be defined as fatherly instruction, God's pedagogy. It prescribes for man the ways, the rules of conduct that lead to the promised beatitude; it proscribes the ways of evil which turn him away from God and his love. It is at once firm in its precepts and, in its promises, worthy of love

CCC1951 Law is a rule of conduct enacted by competent authority for the sake of the common good. The moral law presupposes the rational order, established among creatures for their good and to serve their final end, by the power, wisdom, and goodness of the Creator. All law finds its first and ultimate truth in the eternal law. Law is declared and established by reason as a participation in the providence of the living God, Creator and Redeemer of all. "Such an ordinance of reason is what one calls law."
