





### JESUS LOVES YOU!

He sat on the other end of the pew from me and we would wave at the part we share peace and he smiled on the way out and said he'd pray for me, even though I didn't even know his name. About six months of this on a daily basis, he approached me and handed me a bulletin and he seemed to ask me to read it. I was confused that he seemed to struggle to say the words, until I read the bulletin blurb, that said he was dying of ALS.

He was beginning his own ALS challenge. Instead of the ice bucket challenge, his challenge would be, during the decline of his bodily state, he would attempt to show the world the love of God, through him carrying his cross, so that we would know Jesus loved us so much.

As his health declined it seemed his eyes shined more. I'll never forget the day he greeted me at the door

wearing a bright red t-shirt that said Jesus loves you - with a laptop in his hand. As he held the door for me, I heard the computer speak - Jesus loves you!

Soon after this time, my family and I moved away, and I found out some months later that he had passed. But whenever I think that it is only the big and successful things that I do that matter. Or whenever my cross seems too much to bear, I think of that man with ALS at the door. His eyes shining bright, unable to speak, wearing a bright red shirt - that said - *Jesus loves you* - with a computer in his hand - pressing the button, to help me understand that no matter how heavy the cross, or if it looks like the end, *Jesus loves me*!

Stay I'd go anywhere for you, I would fly to the moon. I would build a city on a hill, I would plant you a garden, I would till, I would till, I would write, I would sing, I would do a million things. But what if you asked me to stay? Could I stand in one place? See all of my work go to waste? Feel the boredom in my bones? Feel worthless and not know? Why you want this thing from me, To stay put and never leave. Have no gifts of mine to share, Just a soul standing here, Loving you!

CCC1505 Moved by so much suffering Christ not only allows himself to be touched by the sick, but he makes their miseries his own: "He took our infirmities and bore our diseases." But he did not heal all the sick. His healings were signs of the coming of the Kingdom of God. They announced a more radical healing: the victory over sin and death through his Passover. On the cross Christ took upon himself the whole weight of evil and took away the "sin of the world," of which illness is only a consequence. By his passion and death on the cross Christ has given a new meaning to suffering: it can henceforth configure us to him and unite us with his redemptive Passion.
