
St. Gianna Novena

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA AND CELEBRATION FOR SUNDAY | APRIL 27, 2025

All are invited to St. Margaret Mary Church, to pray the Novena and Chaplet this Easter Season. The 9 day Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet from <u>Good Friday</u>, <u>April 18th</u>, <u>concludes</u> <u>with adoration</u>, <u>chaplet and benediction @3pm on Divine Mer-</u> <u>cy Sunday</u>, <u>April 27</u>.

This prayer was revealed to St .Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, by our Lord on Good Friday 1937 when our Lord commanded St. Faustina "to make a 9 Day Novena, before the Feast of Mercy (known now as **Divine Mercy Sunday**), this for the conversion of the whole world and the "Restoration" of The Divine Mercy". Our Lord continued, " By reciting this novena, I will grant every possible




grace to souls" all one needs for the novena is your rosary. A prayer book of the Chaplet will be provided.

Our Lord also stated "I desire the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls and especially for poor sinners. On that day (<u>Divine Mercy Sunday</u>) the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy". Also <u>The soul that goes to Confession*, prior to and receives</u> <u>Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment</u>" (Dairy 699). This promise is beyond that of a plenary indulgence which remits temporal punishment but not the remission of the sin.
